AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI AND THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION RELATED TO PROVIDING LITTER REMOVAL AND MOWING OPERATIONS WITHIN THE RIGHT OF WAY AND THE MEDIAN EXTENDING ALONG INTERSTATE I-20 IN THE CITY LIMITS OF CLINTON, MS

## APPROVE A WATER RATE INCREASE FOR WATER USE ABOVE 5.61 MILLION GALLONS PER MONTH FROM THE CURRENT RATE OF \$0.406 PER 1000 GALLONS

Upon presentation by Bill Gilliland, with WGK, Inc., <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Cashion and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Cronin the board approved the water rate increase for water use above 5.61 million gallons per month from the current rate of \$0.406 per 1000 gallons to \$0.930 per 1000 gallons, and furthermore approved the effective date of the increase on November 1, 2015. <u>MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>

## APPROVE THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE OLD VICKSBURG CELL TOWER LEASE BETWEEN THE CITY OF CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI AND NEW CINGULAR WIRELESS PCS, LLC

Upon presentation by Ken Dreher, City Attorney, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderwoman Cossitt and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Barnett the board approved the second amendment to the Old Vicksburg Cell Tower Lease between the City of Clinton, Mississippi and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC contingent upon New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC paying the City \$15,000.00 for prior damage to the water tower. <u>MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>
