Upon presentation by Chelsea Brannon, City Attorney, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Cronin and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Cashion the board authorized the Mayor to execute an Agreement between the City of Clinton, Mississippi and Metrix Solutions in connection with the purchase of Body Cameras, following the review and approval of the City Attorney. <u>MOTION</u> CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

APPROVE A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI AND SEVERN TRENT ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, INC. RELATED TO THE OPERATION, MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE CLINTON WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES

Upon presentation by Chelsea Brannon, City Attorney, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderwoman Cossitt and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Martin the board approved a resolution to approve Amendment Number One to the Agreement between the City of Clinton, Mississippi and Severn Trent Environmental Services Inc. related to the operation, management and maintenance of the Clinton Wastewater Treatment Facilities. <u>MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>
