APROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS A – R

MAYOR'S DISCUSSION AND REPORTS

APPROVE A RESOLUTION FOR UNKEMPT PROPERTY LOCATED AT 122 ROCKBRIDGE CIRCLE – PARCEL 2980-186-264 – WARD 5

Upon presentation by Roy Edwards, Director of Community Development, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Wilbanks and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderwoman Godfrey the board approved a resolution determining the necessity for cleaning the property located at 122 Rockbridge Circle, Parcel 2980-186-264, under the authority granted to municipalities by Section 21-19-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended and other applicable statutes and ordinances. A public hearing was held but no one representing the property owners was present and there was no public comment. The resolution is on file with the City Clerk. <u>MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>

APPROVE A TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE CITY OF CLINTON ZONING ORDINANCE AS IT PERTAINS TO COMMERCIAL VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL AREAS

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CONDITIONAL USE - VERIZON WIRELESS - SCOTLAND ROAD - WARD 6

Upon presentation by Roy Edwards, Director of Community Development, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Lott and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderwoman Oliver the board approved the Conditional Use request from Verizon Wireless for a small cell site to be located on Scotland Road in the City of Clinton, Mississippi. The Planning and Zoning Committee recommended approval. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY**

CONDITIONAL USE - C-SPIRE WIRELESS - 961 HIGHWAY 80 EAST - WARD 6

Upon presentation by Roy Edwards, Director of Community Development, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Wilbanks and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderwoman Godfrey the board approved the Conditional Use request from C-Spire Wireless for a small cell site to be located at 961 Highway 80 East in the City of Clinton, Mississippi. The Planning and Zoning Committee recommended approval. <u>MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>

<u>DIMENSIONAL VARIANCE – CONDITIONAL USE – STORAGE CITY OF CLINTON – 0 CLINTON PARKWAY – PARCEL 2861-10-7 – WARD 1</u>

After discussion of the item a **MOTION** was made by Alderman Wilbanks and **SECONDED** by Alderman Martin to table this item. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY**

<u>DIMENSIONAL VARIANCE – CONDITIONAL USE – STORAGE MAX CLINTON – 0</u> NORTHSIDE DR. – PARCEL 2862-111-374 – WARD 3

Upon presentation by Roy Edwards, Director of Community Development, MOTION made by Alderman Wilbanks and SECONDED by Alderwoman Oliver the board denied the Dimensional Variance and Conditional Use requested by Storage Max Clinton to construct an enclosed, climate-controlled self-storage warehouse to be located at 0 Northside Drive, Parcel 2862-111-374 in the City of Clinton, Mississippi. The denial was based on the fact that the project was not compatible with the surrounding neighborhood, the fact that the building would be two stories, and the fact that the visibility from three sides from the surrounding area was unacceptable. The Architectural Review Committee and the Planning and Zoning Committee recommended approval. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

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<u>DIMENSIONAL VARIANCE – JOEL AND CARRIE THAMES – 4605 WILLIAMSON</u> ROAD – WARD 3

Upon presentation by Roy Edwards, Director of Community Development, MOTION made by Alderman Wilbanks and SECONDED by Alderwoman Godfrey the board approved the Dimensional Variance requested by Joel and Carrie Thames to wave the requirement that the first 100 feet of the driveway be of a solid surface on property located at 4605 Williamson Road in the City of Clinton, Mississippi. The variance approved was to allow a hard surface from the main road to the entrance gate of the property. The Planning and Zoning Committee recommended this request be denied. THE MOTION PASSED BY A VOTE OF 5 TO 1.

THE LEASE TERM BEGINS JANUARY 1, 2022 AND ENDS DECEMBER 31, 2027

RECONSIDERATION OF CHANGE ORDER NO 1 FOR THE 2021 STREET PAVING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Upon presentation by Bill Owen, Consulting City Engineer, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Martin and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Wilbanks the board approved the reconsideration of Change Order No 1 for the 2021 Street Paving Improvements Project. The board approved not to restripe additional streets but to pave an additional street with the money left over from the amount budgeted for the 2021 Street Paving Project. <u>MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>
