DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

Mike Warren, Police Chief updated the board on the Police Department expansion project, the progress in hiring new police officers and the field training of new police officers that started in January 2014. He also, reported to the board the statistics for calls for service, traffic stops, number of tickets written and number of arrests made during the period of February 10, 2014 through February 23, 2014 as compared to the same period in 2013.

Barry Burnside, Fire Chief updated the board on calls for service and fire calls for the period of January 1, 2014 through March 3, 2014 as compared to the same period in 2013. He also updated the board on a motor vehicle accident that occurred on Saturday March 2, 2014 in which five persons were seriously injured, training of certain firefighters for the upcoming captain promotions, participation in trauma classes sponsored by Mississippi College, and upcoming chlorine training classes in handling chlorine leaks.

Mike Parker, Director of Public Works reminded the board of the upcoming Annual City Wide Cleanup that will be held March 29, 2014 through April 5, 2014. He also updated the board on the NRCS drainage project, the Pinehaven Drive expansion project, and the Hampstead Boulevard extension project.

AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO HIRE AN AGENCY FOR THE PURPOSE OF BRANDING THE CITY OF CLINTON

Upon presentation by Phil Fisher, Mayor, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Cashion and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Barnett the board authorized the Mayor to hire Mad Genius for the purpose of branding the City of Clinton. <u>MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>

APPROVE THE ACCEPTANCE OF A \$60,000.00 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S BOMB SQUAD'S EQUIPMENT AND TRAINING

Upon presentation by Michael Warren, Police Chief, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Cronin and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Ellis the board approved the acceptance of a \$60,000.00 Homeland Security Grant for the Police Department's Bomb Squad's equipment and training. <u>MOTION</u> <u>CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>

GRANT APPROVAL TO APPLY FOR A \$67,199.44 OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT TO INCREASE IMPAIRED DRIVING ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS

Upon presentation by Michael Warren, Police Chief, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Barnett and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Martin the board approved grant approval to apply for a \$67,199.44 Office of Highway Safety Grant to increase Impaired Driving Enforcement efforts. <u>MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>

<u>AUTHORIZE THE RENEWAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR FY 2015 WITH</u> <u>THE MISSISSIPPI OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY FOR \$70,570.00</u>

Upon presentation by Michael Warren, Police Chief, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Cashion and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderwoman Cossitt the board authorized the renewal of a grant application for FY 2015 with the Mississippi Office of Highway Safety for \$70,570.00. <u>MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>

AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A ONE (1) YEAR CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI AND ADSI FOR PUBLIC SAFETY SOFTWARE FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND MUNICIPAL COURT SERVICES

Upon presentation by Michael Warren, Police Chief, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Cashion and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Ellis the board authorized the Mayor to execute a one (1) year contract between the City of Clinton, Mississippi and ADSi for public safety software for the Police Department and Municipal Court Services. <u>MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY</u>

APPROVE THE ACCEPTANCE OF A \$50.00 DONATION TO THE CLINTON FIRE DEPARTMENT FROM DIANNE M STEFANICK

Upon presentation by Barry Burnside, Fire Chief, <u>MOTION</u> made by Alderman Ellis and <u>SECONDED</u> by Alderman Barnett the board approved the acceptance of a \$50.00 donation to the Clinton Fire Department from Dianne M. Stefanick. <u>MOTION CARRIED</u> UNANIMOUSLY
