The Mayor recognized the presence of Hinds County Supervisor Tony Greer representing the Hinds County District 4.

The Mayor read a letter from Mike Cashion complementing the Clinton Police Department for their successful efforts in recovering a vehicle stolen from one of his neighbors.

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DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

Michael Warren, Police Chief reported to the board the statistics for calls for service, traffic stops, number of tickets written and the number of arrests for the period November 10, 2014 through December 31, 2014 as compared to the same period in 2013. The Chief also discussed reasons for the increase in burglaries as compared to 2013.

Barry Burnside, Fire Chief reported the statistics on the number of service calls including medical and fire calls for the period January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014 as compared to the same period in 2013. The chief informed the board that the Lindale siren was still out of commission, the ladder truck was currently down, that the department would begin a new hiring process for three new firefighters, that he was meeting with architects for the design of the new Station #4, there was one firefighter at the Firefighter Training Academy, that three firefighters would be starting the EMT training classes, there would be a gas pipeline meeting, a Fire Chief's conference, a meeting to discuss a railroad disaster incident and a Community Emergency Response team meeting in the coming month. The Chief also explained to the board that the Department would continue in house training of firefighters.

Cole Smith, Director of Parks and Recreation introduced Adam Wade as the new Assistant Director of Maintenance and Athletics for the department. Cole then updated the board on the activity the department was involved in with the sports associations regarding the donations of money for the upgrading and maintenance of the various athletic fields and the status of the sponsorship packages program.


