<u>UNKEMPT PROPERTY – SOUTH RECTANGLE DRIVE (TAX PARCEL #2862-111-74)</u> <u>– WARD 1</u>

Upon presentation by Roy Edwards, Director of Community Development, MOTION made by Alderman Ellis and SECONDED by Alderman Martin the board approved a resolution determining the necessity for cleaning the property and demolishing the house located at South Rectangle Drive (Tax Parcel #2862-111-74), under the authority granted municipalities by Section 21-19-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended and other applicable statutes and ordinances. Furthermore, the board gave the owners of the property until October 20, 2020 to have the house demolished. If the house was not demolished by then the City would move in to demolish the house. A public hearing was held and Bessie McElroy owner of the property was present. Ms. McElroy stated that she realized that the house on the property needed to be demolished and that it would be taken care of. She also informed the board that they had someone interested in buying the property and if the sale went through it would close on October 20, 2020. There was no public comment.
