1. Clinton's population is 24,600 with a 125,000 person trade area. 34,000 vehicles pass Clinton daily on I-20. You Belong Here.
2. 31.62% of the respondents make 50% or more of their purchase outside of Clinton (Q4), while 90.53% would buy in Clinton if they had more opportunities (Q8). You Belong Here.
