### <u>PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE 2016 – 2017 CITY OF CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI</u> BUDGET AND TAX LEVY

A Public Hearing on the City's proposed fiscal year 2016-2017 budget and tax levy was led by Mayor Phil Fisher. Mayor Fisher read a letter explaining the proposed budget and tax levy. This letter has been made a part of these minutes. One citizen asked if the budget would be available to the public before the final vote. She was told that the budget and the letter the Mayor read would be posted on the City's web site the next morning. Alderman Cronin commented that he was very happy with the growth of police officers and the addition of an Inspector position in the Community Development Department in this budget. He also commented on the 11.5% growth in Clinton over the last three years and wanted the citizens to know that they were a part of this growth. Alderman Cashion commented that our employees were a great asset to the City and he wanted to let the citizens know that this budget did not include a millage increase. He also wanted the citizens to know that over the last three years the board has been consistent in allocating the resources and that the board intended to continue to be consistent and to meet the priorities that were set at the beginning of this term. Alderman Brabham commented that he believes that this budget speaks to the quality of life that the board is striving for in this City. He believes that this quality of life sets us apart from the other municipalities in Hinds County. There being no further comments from those attending the Public Hearing or from the board the Mayor declared the Public Hearing closed.
